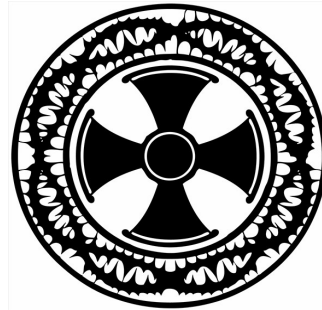
Saturday 21st July 10.30 am - 3 pm.

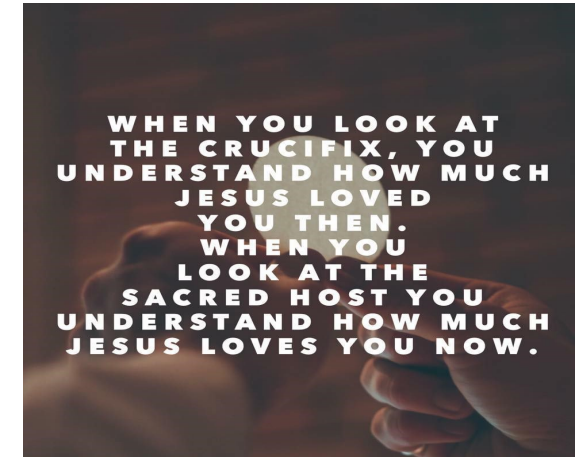

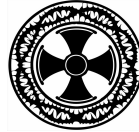

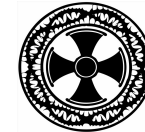
