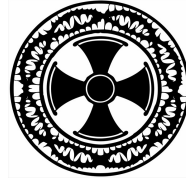

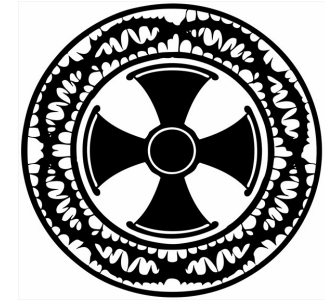

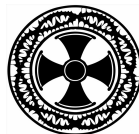
Knit & Natter

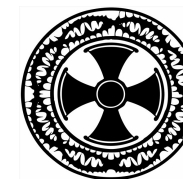
