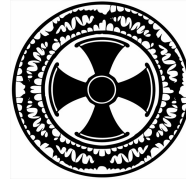

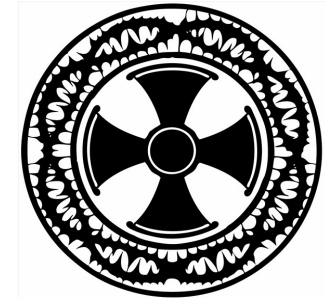

### Saturday Coffee Shop in aid of Charity

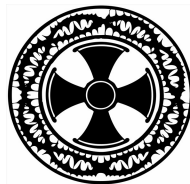

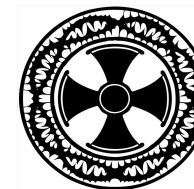
