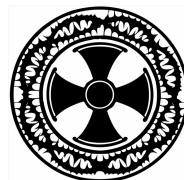

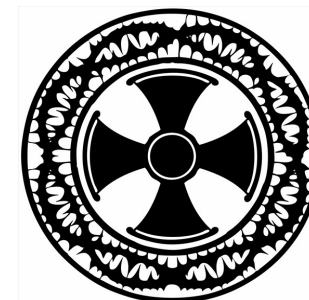

The Coffee Shop is run every Saturday from 10am to 1pm.

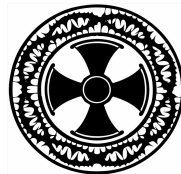
The Coffee shop has so far this year raised for charity:

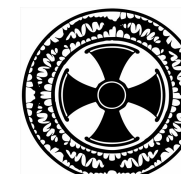
