Tickets £5 on the door.

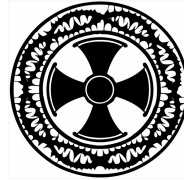

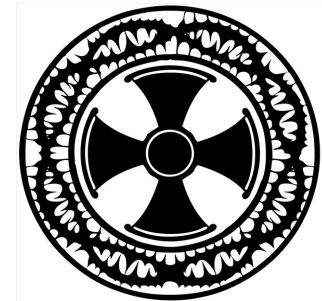

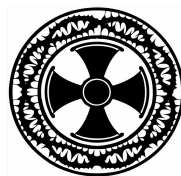
### Knit & Natter

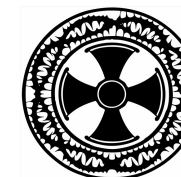
