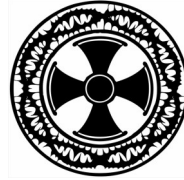

Parish Social Event.

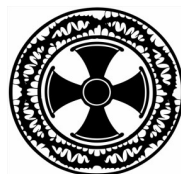
Wednesday, 3rd October 7.00pm , at the Adelfia, a Greek restaurant, in Preston Street, Brighton.

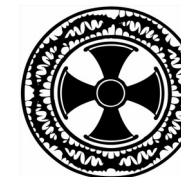
