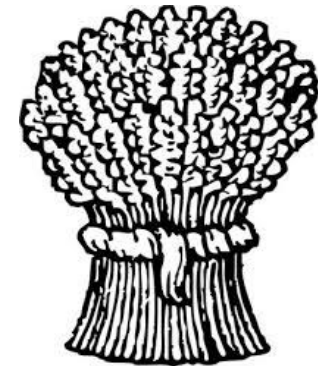

Richard will collect the £17 in advance - if you could pay by Sunday 30th September. Thank you.

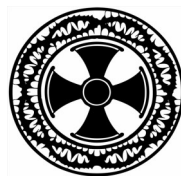
