We need books, bottles (full) and unwanted gifts, no 'Bric a Brac' or clothes.

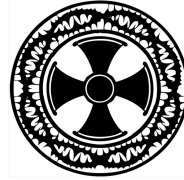

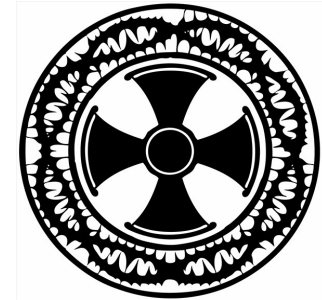

Knit & Natter

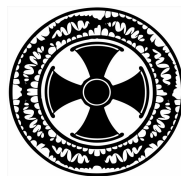

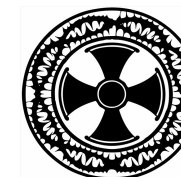
