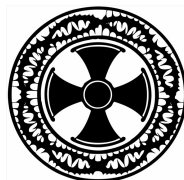

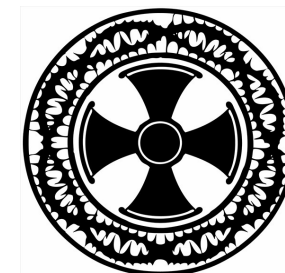

" Thank you very much for your donation of food and money from your harvest festival to The Clock Tower Sanctuary.

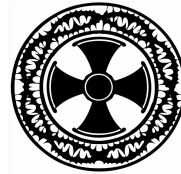

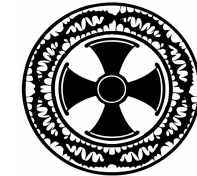
