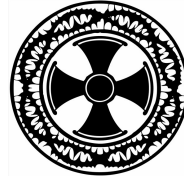

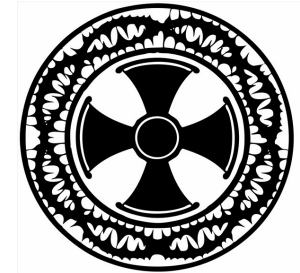

It is the task of all of us to ensure best safeguarding practice. Please remember not to take pictures of others, without their permission and share on social media.

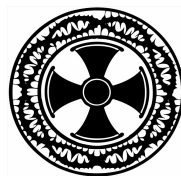

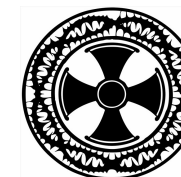
