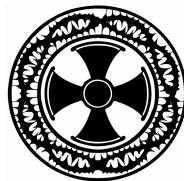

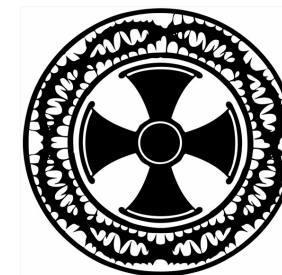

Calling all budding bake off contestants, please could you make a large cake so we can sell at the Christmas Fair. (Please list ingredients for people with allergies) Thank you.

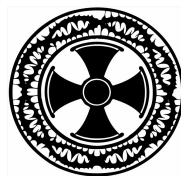

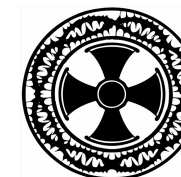
