I'm hoping Fr. Martin Poole, the Vicar of Prestonville will be available for my 20th anniversary here at the Chapel Royal.

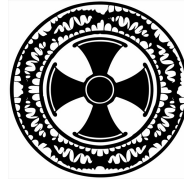
