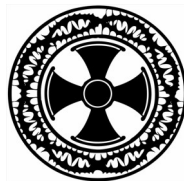
Sunday 30th June this year marks the ten years since we became again a separate Parish from St. Peter's. What amazing things God has done in those 10 years. Thanks be to God.

Parish Meal

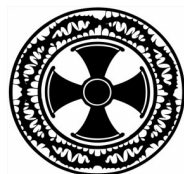

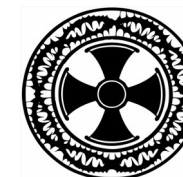
