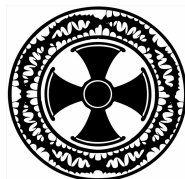
Sunday 28th April will mark the 20th Anniversary of my first incarnation in 1999.

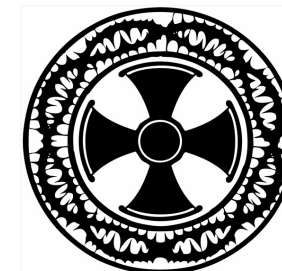

Weekly giving envelopes

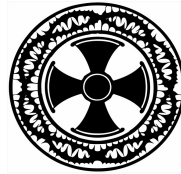

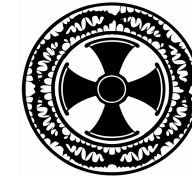
