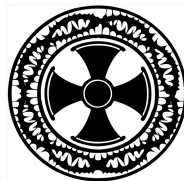

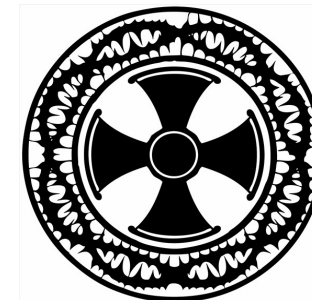

Electoral Roll

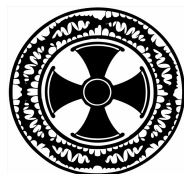
Every four years the electoral reaches a cycle where all have to renew their applications to remain a member.

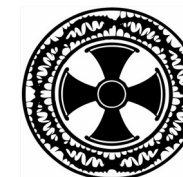
