It was to be a temporary 3 year appointment either to develop the church after the 1995 re-ordering or to close the church down!

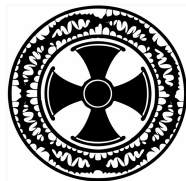
Sunday 30th June this year marks the ten years since we became again a separate Parish from St. Peter's.

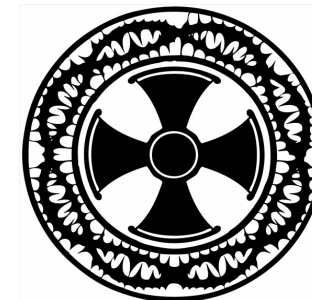

The forms are on the table by the front door. Thank you.

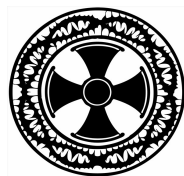
Brighton Marathon

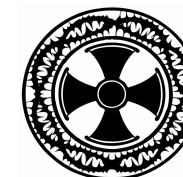
