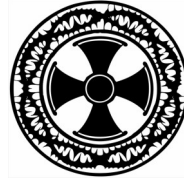
Sunday 30th June this year marks the ten years since we became again a separate Parish from St. Peter's. What amazing things God has done in those 10 years. Thanks be to God.

### Parish Meal

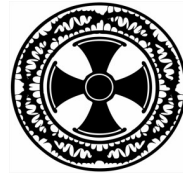
**Parish meal 28th April at The Jury's Inn. Richard requires outstanding monies to be paid by Sunday 7th April.**

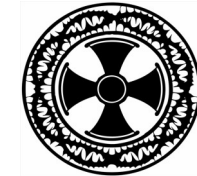
