Sunday 30th June this year marks the ten years since we became again a separate Parish from St. Peter's. What amazing things God has done in those 10 years.

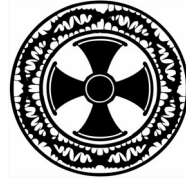
Thanks be to God.

Parish Meal

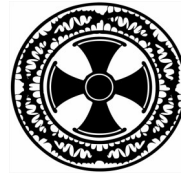
Parish meal 28th April at The Jury's Inn. Richard requires outstanding monies to be paid by next Sunday 7th April.

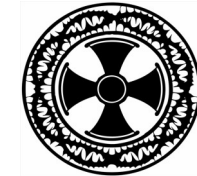
