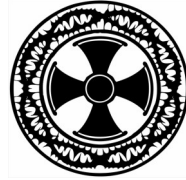
Easter Day 21st April 10.15 am

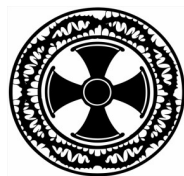
Parish Meal

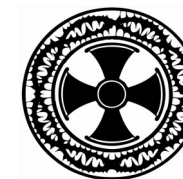
