This year Thy Kingdom Come celebration will take place at the Dome in Brighton on Sunday, 9th June. The keynote speaker will be Roy Crowne from Hope Together. Roy became Hope Together's executive director in March 2010 and was previously the national director of youth for Christ in Britain for 12 years.

Stuart Barbour, a singer and songwriter from Sussex, will be providing worship music and Rev Martin Poole will be applying his usual creativity, using both traditional and contemporary ways, to provide a visual effect in a way that helps everyone to worship God and be inspired by the Spirit.

Bishop Richard is leading on the day. He said: Prayer spaces will be open from 2pm to 6pm for people to drop in any time that they like, and a programme of workshops on these themes will be available soon. This ecumenical event will be followed by an evening of worship event from 7pm.
