



## Liturgical Celebrations while Fr. David is away

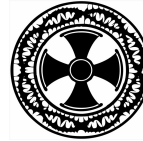
During August, Fr. Martin Morgan

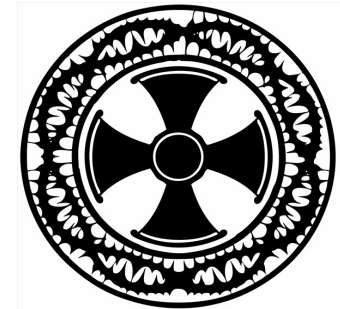
