During August services will only be celebrated on a Sunday and Wednesday morning.

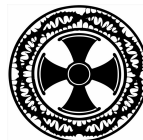
Apologies to those who are regular communicants on Tuesdays, Thursdays and for the Saturday evening Vigil Mass.

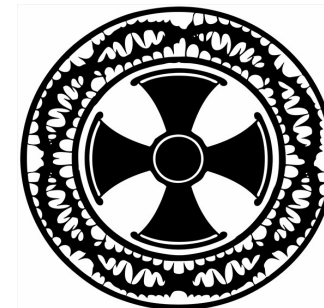
