Apologies to those who are regular communicants on Tuesdays, Thursdays and for the Saturday evening Vigil Mass.

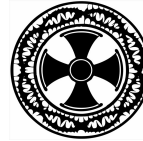
In September the services will revert to normal.

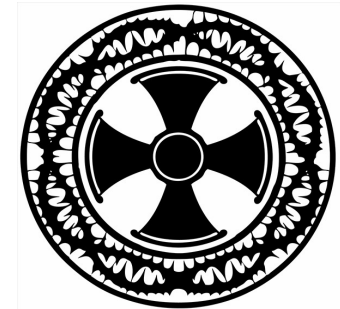
