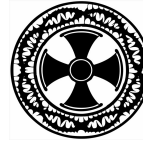


Liturgical Celebrations

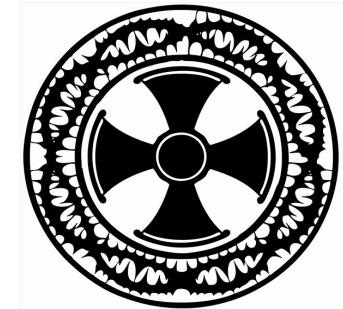
