For the Autumn term we welcome Catherine Murphy who is a Diocesan Ordinand in her second year of training discernment.

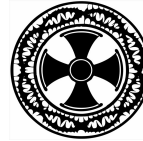

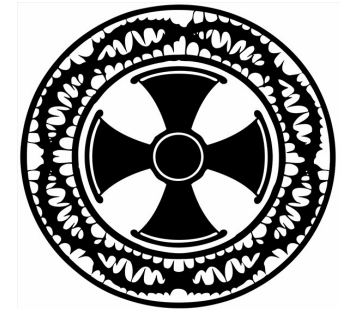
