Service of Remembrance at St Lukes, Queen's Park - 11th December

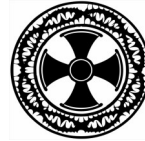
Healing Ministry at Mass.

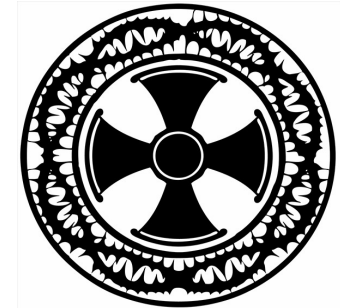
